

SPAMJADOO SERVER INSTALLATION WORKSHEET

Please ensure that you have installed Redhat Advance Server or equivalent, along with Postgresql 7.4 database installed. Please feel free to contact us via email at support@datainfocom.in to get more support or call + 91 141 5110555.

1. Connectivity to the Server on which SpamJadoo will be installed:

IP Address of Server (SSH/Telnet)	61.19.242.85
Login Id of Server	root
Login Password Server	Spamjad00
Port 25 should not be used by any other application. It is reserved for Spamjadoo Service.	

2. Default Domain name information you want to protect with Spamjadoo.:

Your Company Domain Name	yourdomain.com
Outgoing Server (SMTP) IP and Port (smtp server setting in your mail client)	61.19.242.85 port 25 or smtp.yourdomain.com port 25
POP3 IP	61.19.242.85 or pop.yourdomain.com

**3. List of IP Addresses that are allowed to send emails through SpamJadoo as subscribers:
(normally its your own LAN IP pool)**
